Hello my name is Mary Kern, I'm the president of the Shamanic Astrology Mystery School, and we have a wonderful vlog cast coming for us today with Daniel Giamario, our founder. We're going to be discussing the 300 Years for Global humanity involusion or evolution?" And today, we'll be exploring what global humanity is currently experiencing. And Daniel will be talking about the Great Awakening versus the Dark Night of the Soul, and answering the question "is this a great reset or is it an inversion?" So with that, we'll be examining the evidence through an astrological lens, using our signature three-world approach. There'll be a variety of subjects being covered including hierarchical patriarchy, demise of the matrilineal family structure and much more. So with that, I'm going to ask Daniel to just begin.

Thank you Mary, we're back again for our monthly vlog cast covering a great deal of different subjects. And today,

and this is actually kind of a preparation for what the school is going to be presenting as we approach the the December Solstice, which is on the grand subject of "The Turning of the Ages." And this is kind of an expansion of that. It actually connects in with one of my one of my great side interests over the years, which is looking at history, looking at long cycles of history, speculation on where global humanity is at at this point. In other words, we're going to be looking actually further back than just one 26,000 year cycle. There's a wide variety of sources for this. It also includes strong connections to one of my side projects over the years, which was the Renaissance of the Sacred trips that I would do around the world, and the research I've done in different parts of the world, and also exploring the vast amount of new information that's come through over the last five or ten years in archaeology / anthropology. And used to be that when i would give this presentation that we're going to look at now, it would happen at the very end of those yearly trips to places like Wales and Scotland and Ireland. And the title of what I would always share at the end, with always updated information was "Who are We and What the Heck Happened?" So it's like, what does it mean to actually be human and then, are we in a process of linear evolution or is it something else going on here at this time period? And so, that's the basic sense of what we're going to look at. And we'll also be always suggesting that we look at this with the Signature Approach of our school of the three-worlds approach, to to be able to see it

from a Celestial perspective, from a Middle World or ordinary reality perspective, but also from the perspective of the Underworld, and the lower world on mysteries.

So let's, I think maybe a good way to get started would be usually, in our school what we present is the Turning-of-the-Ages viewpoint, which is that we are AT the end and the beginning of a Great 26,000-year cycle. Recently, through research and all, so through the insight of someone named **Lisa Renee** it was suggested that actually it may be where we're at currently is 12 times 12 processional cycles. And that would actually, if you just did the math, it's 312,000 years or so, right. But I'm not attached to a number like that, so what I'm just using in general like around 300,000 years. Well it's very interesting that in **modern** research you can actually now stretch the existence of our type of human on this planet back 300,000 years. So it keeps being taken further back and further back. And a lot of this comes from recent research that's been done in Australia actually, where there's a whole group of scientists down there. That and researchers that are suggesting that "out of Africa," may NOT be accurate, and may *actually* be "out of Australia," where the Dreamtime first created the world we're in. That that is where it took place, and as we've actually discovered more and more versions of the *homo species* that we are - there's now seven or eight of them that have been found - that the whole situation seems to be far more complex than what we had thought. And this keeps expanding. I kind of like the idea

of 12 times 12, and particularly as its ramifications for the time we're in now. Our school has a adjustment, our school has always presented the idea that *we are at the end and the beginning of a processional cycle*. BUT, we also see it as a *zone* and that zone would be from **1962 to 2034**. Let's still make another adjustment here, by the way, for those that are watching this, actually Mary and I are in *opposite* sides of the world, so she is at sunset. And at this time of year, from where i'm speaking to you from in outside of metro Manila, this is the time of year where the Sun is directly shining on me here in the office and i have them yellow golden curtains, and so that's the glow. It's kind of like having non-led light, when you have the nice orange glow coming through right or yellow, so that's what's happening i can't make it any different than the way it is, so we've also in the past discussed a lot about that.

This is the end or the bottoming out of Kali Yugas, which is a whole other way of looking at where we are in time and I very much have used the most recent research that was done and we've actually talked about this in other presentations about the research done by a man named Bibu Dev Mishra, "The End of the Kali Yugas in 2025, Unraveling the Mysteries of the Yuga Cycle," and that will also be included, for those who haven't seen it, as part of this some vlog cast...Mary why don't you put up the Yuga first. We can just briefly go through the front piece again briefly, which summarizes what we're going to talk about. And then go to the Kali Yugas chart

Okay

"300,000 Years for Global Humanity: Evolution or Involution?" Are we going up? Are we going down? This is also associated with the idea of "are we in linear progress rather than cycles," is only a modern, more modern artifact. I mean that's not the way global humanity looked at things for a much longer period of time. Just briefly go through this because we're going to cover every one of these points

... I'm just gonna talk about all of that . . . Let's go to **the Kali Yuga chart**. I am in the midst of doing **research** to be able to have **a chart that matches the dates of the different 12 Ages within a processional cycle of the 26,000 years**. And it pretty interestingly matches the way that **Bibu the Pundit**, who created this modern research with the Kali Yuga, and you'll see here on this that the previous Kali Yugas started about 24,676 BC, over 26,000 years is when that began. And then you would see where the Sat Yuga would be. The ascending Sat Yuga at 15,676 BC, and then the *end* of the Sat Yuga about 14-15,000 years ago, 12,676 BC. Now, you can see the *current* Kali Yuga began **3676BC**. And that's a really interesting time period *because* so many **great world calendars** began around that time. It was not that far away from the *beginning* of the Mayan Long Count. Also, it was when we have the appearance of the very first abstract language, the cuneiform script of Sumeria and then that actually relates to an idea that a lot of people have had that is actually a fairly well-known book called "The

Alphabet *versus* the Goddess," that describes how the creation of abstract language, rather than sort of petroglyphs or picture language and another kind of symbolism, began the whole thing of *separating humans from the creation* and actually was **an attack on the matrilineal** and more goddess-oriented cultures. And so, we also could say it's around that time, it's the beginning of recorded history around that time period, and that was one fourth of the way back in the Great Processional Cycle.

Now you'll look and see that the the **Kali Yuga** itself will stretch from **BC** to 2025–2025 like five, four years from NOW. So we're like, you could say, we're coming out of the Kali Yuga. The density of the Kali Yuga has already happened and that will lead us Mary, to a speculation near the end of our presentation here today, regarding. "Are we *slowly* emerging from the bottom of Kali Yuga? Are we slowly moving into a NEW processional cycle, OR is it something more dramatic happening, like the movement from **Kali Yugas** to a Sat Yuga for example?"

We'll consider that later on....go down a little further on this slide if you can, there's some notes here. This is what I hope to create a more expanded view of for our **December Solstice** presentation, one we're doing at the end of the year in particular.

You can see here that there are **different North Stars**. So **Vega** was the **North Star 13,000 to 11,000 BC**. BUT one of the things i've *always* found most incredible

is the fact that it was during the most recent Sat Yuga, that the star **Deneb**, which is in the Milky Way, *was* the North Star. And that is **the only time in a processional cycle, WHEN the Milky Way is perpendicular to the horizon** right. So basically, we'd have all these world cultures that would have some kind of a bird at the top of the World Tree. This is like pretty *universal* symbol. Sometimes it's a **swan**, sometimes it's a **vulture**, sometimes it's an **eagle**. So you ascend the World Tree too, but when it's along the Milky Way, that is not the way that it is now - it's *only* during, it seems, only during a Sat Yuga where that situation happens.

I'm also very fascinated, beyond the scope of our conversation here today, with HOW, around **3200 BC, Aldebaran** was ON the Vernal Equinox, and then Helical rise of the **Pleiades** at the Vernal Equinox was about over **5000 years ago**. So that is right at the beginning of the current Kali Yuga. Now, I love synchronicity, and one of the sources where I get sometimes inspiration from, is something that Graham Hancock puts out, his team, puts out *every* week, which are the recent discoveries in **archaeology** and **anthropology** and **archaeoastronomy**. And I just today saw this remarkable article, "The World's Oldest Story," Astronomers say global myths about the Seven Sisters or the Pleiades, may reach back a 100K years. Now the Australians, the aboriginal, states *further* back thanthat. But, the thing that is so cool about this article, and we'll include it as from this Vlog cast, is they're showing that 100K

years ago, one of the stars of the Pleiades would have been seen as a **double star**. So that actually, it would have been seen as seven... if you go further back. And so, it's describing how this whole legend or myth of the Seven Sisters was from the time, that it was seen as seven, which I thought was a very very intriguing. So we're talking about *ancient* knowledge here. Speaking of the Kali Yuga, and this will then *transition* us into the next part of our inquiry. Let's look at the Kali Yuga thin.

THIS was is from an amazing book called, "Voices of the First Day: Awakening in the Aboriginal Dreamtime," one of my favorite researchers Robert Lawlor, and this was in his book. His words, "The concluding age, the one we live in now, is the most degenerate, when separateness and division becomes open conflict. "It is called the 'Kali Yugas,' and in time becomes an incarnation of destruction."

The Vishnu Pranas a mythological text of the Hindus, and this is over 2000-years old, described it this way, "Kali brought sin into the world, in the Kali Age, the proper order of human relations is reversed. Social status depends upon the ownership of property; wealth has become the only source of virtue; passion and luxury are the sole bonds between spouses; falsity and lying are the conditions of success in life; sexuality is the sole source of human enjoyment; religion a superficial and empty ritual, is confused with spirituality."

Can you imagine a more spot-on description of what could be called at our current time, "The Great Inversion." I mean one example of that would be the fact that for long periods of time, to be a king or a queen, or to be a philosopher king or the ruler of some kind, the first thing they had to have was spiritual initiation.

Well now, look at the people who are actually running the show. I mean it's just a really like a perfect description of what is described in here by the "division of Vishnu Pranas," and I think they call out WHY it is what we're seeing happening may in fact be *involution* rather than *evolution*. Okay, this will be part, you'll have this same quote, this part of the Vlogcast.

I would like to now go into some of the other indicators. So there's a number of different things that are indicators I think of it being here at this point more *involution* than *evolution*. And in involution, I'm talking about *spirit into matter*, rather than some kind of up-and-out sort of thing. I'm using involution and evolution in kind of ... think, if we look at the 300 000 years as cycles, or we could also think of them as waves. So there would be like sort of up and down, and up and down, and up and down. And so, the Sat Yuga is like up here, and then it descends down to Kali Yuga, and then it goes back up in cycles. So what I've noticed in exploring world culture is that one of the symbols and Lawlor's Researchers as well as others, point this out. That one of the hallmarks of Kali Yugas, is that

patriarchy becomes dominant. So that actually, for a much larger time period in human history, that we have a matrilineal family descent. Now, I'm not exposing matriarchy as an opposite of patriarchy, but we're speaking here of a situation that is so beautifully written by people like the research of Maria Combutas, Riane Eisler, "Chalice and the Blade," "Sacred Pleasure." It was Riane Eisler who brought out that beautiful concept of *guylini*(?) of a culture that's collaborative, that is a partnership-based and sharing-based. And it's my contention, based upon - not mainstream - basically not the doctrine of the universities that are holding an agenda, is that for a much longer period of time, human beings were that - they were collaborative, it was an equality, an equal collaboration between men and women. It wasn't what like in Kali Yuga, where it's about separation and division. And that in fact if we go all the way back, there are many cultures and hunter-gatherer times where it wasn't... It was actually a dual system where there would be both matrilineal and patrilineal that would be equal. Actually the original culture of Polynesia was that way, where the family lineage would go through the oldest son and the oldest daughter. But then in other parts of the world it was clearly established through matrilineal descent. But that a feature of the End Times, in the bottom of a Kali Yuga time, is patriarchy. It's the only time it emerges and it represents like the kind of thing that needs to be there it seems, for there to be the composting to happen, if we can put it that way. I've

always been fascinated by the remnants of matrilineal traditions around the world and that is, and Mary, you've been on some of our trips I know, and we go to those places where it's still in the land. All right, the other another thing that seems to happen as we descend into a Kali Yuga, as we descend into the-end-and-the-beginning of a processional cycle, is that what had previously been a worldwide - shamanic/animistic spirituality, where we have many gods and many goddesses, who are primarily forces of nature, plants, animals, stars, mountains, the weather, and so on - all got subsumed into one dominant god. Now this is a very different thing than appreciating that all the gods and goddess exist within a unity, they're expressions of wholeness, but it's the establishment of this one monotheistic god, *almost always male*, is actually therefore connected to the same kind of descent, which is patrilineal. It's way, beyond the scope of this conversation, actually Riane Eisler tries to explore it. Others have tried to explore it ... so on a more materialistic level of "why did it happen?" I'm giving kind of a wider view of "this is what happens at this time in the larger cycles." Connected with this would be the doctrine, which is called Dominion, which comes from the Christian tradition, but it also comes from the peculiar, sort of European view of colonization. But it's deeper than that. It's the idea that human beings have the dominion over the creation. And if you put that together with "The Alphabet versus the Goddess," abstract language,

and it's all about separating humans from the creation, which was completely contrary to hundreds of thousands of years of human history where humans were part of the creation. We were connecting, "as above, so below." That we were kind of an organ of perception, that was there experiencing, as part of creation, not rulership over it. So, I think that's a very important point. So we have the abstract language, we have dominion, you can see this even in the way that the law is written. Actually, the European explorers believed they had the right to take anything from people who didn't believe in private property. So that if they didn't believe in ownership of land or private property, that they were not fully human, and that gave them the right to do it - that was written in the law. It's actually still in the law of the supreme court, and I have documents on that to show that it's why native americans don't really own their land, I mean they have... they're called a Nation, but they don't really have a title to it. But they never believed that you should have a title to it, so therefore it's owned by the corporation. These are all hallmarks as you saw in the great quote of the features of the Kali Yuga. And bringing up every one of these, which, every one of them could have a much longer section. I'm just listing them all out. right now. It's what i call 'the myth of linear progress,' which is seems to be doctrinaire in the current academic world. Obviously there's exceptions to that breaking through, but it's the idea that we, that even at the end of the 19th century, that believe "we know now everything we need to know." It was the

most extreme version of "settled science," that you ever imagine, and this then became, is now, been turned into a religion that is called "scientism," where it's no longer about inquiry and testing and hypothesis, and so on. But it's a belief that we have this ascent, linear progress.

How could those people have built the pyramids? How could the ancients have known that? I mean as if they didn't know there's all kinds of ancient technologies that have been suppressed, and that the ancients, we don't know for sure what they were, but what in our arrogance gives us the right to say, they didn't have something that was more more beautiful than the kind of power systems and energy systems that we have today.

So I mean "the myth of progress," is about linear. And what I'm suggesting here is that for long periods of time it was oscillation up and down, and up and down, and and so, "where are we now?" That's a big question.

So let me just pause for a moment as I have thrown out too these, by the way, in previous talks I frequently have called the first four I've called it "The Quadruple Aberration," which went into "Who are we, and what happened?" Because essentially, what humans have been for a long period of time, is hard to remember what that is. And it's certainly not becoming more AI...in my opinion. I mean to me, that's the Kali Yuga thing also, it's like the destruction of our basic humanity, our connection to the earth and the land and the sky, and our heart and our soul, and

our spirit and consciousness itself, right. Thoughts on all of this Mary?

M- I'm just aware that modern research is showing that the whole idea of evolution doesn't even work. That these changes that came about in human existence didn't happen gradually. And they're actually finding now that it pretty much happened all at one time. And so, it kind of kicks out everything that we've learned traditionally, in our school system. And of course, we've unearthed these incredible cultures all over the world, many of them using pyramid forms and other sacred geometry, subtly different, vibrationally a little bit different. And they're concluding that there was a very specific reason for that. I think there's a lot of evidence that we've had much higher cultures, that we've communicated beyond this planet, with some of these sacred sites that you've taken people to Daniel, and that these are receivers and transmitters. And there's just a whole beautiful array of evidence that is challenging everything that we've ever thought about our culture and how we came to be here.

D- So yeah, a good example of that is that it wasn't until the last a few decades that the doctrine of geology was gradualism, and they would immediately throw out any view of that there was ever any major catastrophes. That whether it was an asteroid strike or it was like the sudden melting of the ice. And it is now like pretty well established, that there if we look at the northern part of the world. if you look at

North America, that there was a great Ice Age that was happening, and they come every so often. And that happened all through, I mean all the way back as to 24-25,000 years ago. It was the onset of that Great Ice Age in Europe, North America and so on. But it was already melting, it was already diminishing, when this event happened. And that event happened right at the halfway point in **the processional cycle**, like about halfway back, 12,800 years ago. Actually it's almost exactly the same date that it was used by Plato in describing the destruction of Atlantis. It's pretty amazing how that matches up. But now it seems pretty clear that some event happened, whether it was a cometary impact, a solar event, but something happened that caused a freeze up, that was more more frozen than the height of the actual Ice Age. And so this lasted for about 1200 years. So, it's called the "Younger Dryas," among geologists. And everything froze up like crazy, and mainly of course, being European-centric, a lot of the looking at "well what happened to North America," it certainly wasn't happening around the equator, which is I believe where civilization is, wherever we use *that* word was existing during the Ice Age and it was doing quite well. But then, what happened is that you have this incredible freeze up and then it has now been established something else happened. And most of the researchers I follow, Robert Schock being one of them, I was pretty convinced that it was a like a *micro anova* or a solar, and in the course of just a short number of years, it melted,

and it was during that time period that the oceans went up about 300 meters, large areas of land were submerged, including the heartland of the great civilization that was in South Asia, around Indonesia and between Malaysia and Indonesia, Sunderland. It also happened in other parts of the world, but this is now known to this have land but i mean we can't conclusively say what it was. Most and also non-mainstream geologists, will say that it was a cometary impact, and they've even kind of located it is coming from the Taurian, the Taurian meteor shower and there's a lot of information out about that. And all I know is that yeah, something dramatic happened at that point, and then also, something even more dramatic happened 1200 years after that. And so *catastrophism* is now accepted. You can see the remains of it in the Badlands area of Oregon. If you drive out of Portland, and you go toward Idaho, you can absolutely see the remains of the way the water had washed away the soil and you see the gullies that were happening by vast floods that happened at that particular time. So that's just one example about how the consensus mainstream view has shifted. Another is that 'Oh, humans only showed up in America in the Clovis Culture, 12 000 years ago. They came down the land bridge.' There are countless studies now that show human presence in north and south America way earlier than that. In fact, there's a great book I would suggest called "America Before," by Graham Hancock going into a lot of it including the discovery that there's DNA in

Amazonian, some of the hunter-gatherer tribes that still exist in the Amazon that have DNA that's only found among people from New Guinea and Australia. So how does that happen? I mean that's certain that for that to be like that, it has to be older than 70,000 years. And they can tell that but by the mutation rate of DNA, that in order to have a certain kind of complexity of DNA, it requires a certain amount of years for the mutations to happen. One of the more out-there theoreticians about this suggests that how that happened, was that there were people, when the climate was different the coastline of Antarctica was exposed, and so they would take their boats from Australia, along the coastline of Antarctica, and then go into South America. It's very very compelling, but it really requires a much more expanded view of what has happened on this planet - most of it covered up. I think we were just talking about this before, not today, but at another time about how many of the giant skeletons have been covered up

M- Wow yes

D- A lot of books on that, that there was a version of humanity that was a lot taller and it may actually be represented by the Gobekli Tepi monoliths or the ones that Callanish actually representing the Elite who were at that point, the Seed People from the destruction that had happened before. I know we've talked about a lot of these things in the past and so this is just a way of summarizing some of these

points. So, when I first started sharing the Kali Yuga stuff, together with the processional material and then looking honestly at the state of global humanity, and how it's being run at this point and who are the celebrities, who are considered to be the heroes of the game, it's power and money, and how many armaments you have, which is completely contrary to how it had been for long periods of time in history. I thought for a long time following the wave pattern, that if you're at the bottom of Kali Yuga, if you're at the end and the beginning of a processional cycle, then it's like a slow ascent back up to a Golden Age. There are those that have looked at this, and even looking more deeply into the documents provided by the gentleman I described who did the research on the Kali Yuga, it's not specific or inherent in there that it would be this slow ascent right. And so. some voices are basically saying, and I'm beginning to suspect that if anything, that I'm saying has any veracity, any truth, that coming out of this bottoming out of this Kali Yugas, if it's within the framework of 12 times 12 of them or 300 000 years of global humanity, it well may be that the next step is going into a Golden Age, right. That it's actually shifting in to something that has been referred to as "Prime Earth." Now what, where would that be? Where would Prime Earth be? And there's a lot of different views about that, because of course, if you look at it *from* the "middle world" perspective or even from an "underworld" perspective, it doesn't look good for the Earth. But, if we don't

have a purely human-centric approach, then I think Gaia or the Sun is going to have something to do with it. There's a concern, I'm sure that those powers, you know, Great Mystery, the powers of Great Mystery love the planet as much as we do, and we'll do whatever is necessary for its revival

M - What about also the part of the galaxy that our solar system is moving through, out in the one arm of the Milky Way? I've actually heard it said that we are approaching a Photon Belt and the light from that is part of it.

D - It's too bad we don't have a graph on that, but it has to do a slide on that. It has to do with the fact that if you imagine the plane of the Galaxy and we're kind of an outlier, we're not that close to Galactic Center. That there's an oscillation over long periods of time up and down, relative to the plane. So there's only certain times in much longer cycles, that our solar system is kind of in the center of the plane. So it's receiving like the direct hit from what is being emanated from the Galactic Center. And this oh-my-gosh this Mary this goes back to the 1970s, where people were talking about, "oh the Photon Belt," but it also includes the fact that we're moving into a *zone*, and NASA knows this. We're moving into a zone of space surrounding the solar system. It's like the solar system is moving through a zone, there's a lot more stuff, I mean so it's not just more cosmic rays, more beams coming through, accelerating things on one or the other level, but it's also more debris.

So there's a lot more stuff being detected out there. Is it just because we only started looking for it? I don't know, but some would say that there really is more right.

So there's that factor. Also, like the fact that the solar system in a much larger cycle. I mean if we looked at this whole thing all the way back. I only took it back 300,000 years, human history, global humanity right. But our species, the experiment of spirit-into-matter – who we are, all right. But if we took it back further while the solar system goes around Galactic Center in **260 million years**. Now that's another larger cycle, and then it goes back to I mean “consensus” in the mainstream is that it all started with a “Big Bang.” I personally have a different view. I mean I think there could have been that, but I'm much more a steady-state person thinking that the creation is eternal. So there's not like, because if you go back to a Big Bang, well then nobody answers the question, “What was before that?” I think that it's a perpetual birthing and dying, and birthing and dying, and up and down, and up and down. And it's hard for me to see much going on that shows that it's like going up, unless the deepest descent, the deepest dark night, the deepest point of composting, and that composting is unlikely in my view, to be done by humans totally. In other words, they will not be allowed to completely destroy, the Earth I mean the Earth will be restored one way or another. So that's why, I think, the question is, “So where's Prime Earth?”

I mean Lynne was telling me she heard from one of the people, one of the sources she follows, this is using the model that there are extraterrestrial races. I mean I can do 300,000 years of history without including that, it makes it more controversial and most of the people I study can look at it as *hybridization* just even on this planet. It doesn't even require that, but I'm not close to that being happening, but she was telling me this view that she said that the good aliens right, our good space brothers are waiting for things getting really bad on this planet and we'll be taken off for a while. And then the 300-year transition zone is the cleanup of the planet, which requires of course, a lot of collateral damage. So you have the whole cleanup of the planet and then people who really love the Earth will be brought back and then we find the Earth is again Prime Earth. I kind of like that the way of looking at it

M- The idea that during the Kali Yuga **only 25 of the heart is available**. Now that comes from the Vedas doesn't it, or what is it?

D- yes

M-And it so ties in to the slide that we had and describing what it would be like at this time and it also kind of feeds into the idea of “the Aquarian Dispensation,” that humanity would arrive at this same time, needing to awaken to their own divinity, their own connectedness to spirit, which has always been there, but which has been hidden. With all of the energy medicine

and people really learning how to tune into spirit and co-create with spirit, I mean that was not something I was very mindful of before my introduction to Shamanic Astrology, and some of the other

D- Yeah. Thank you for remembering about that. So let me kind of explain that a little bit more because there's two different issues here. The one about that, in each of the four Yugas. In Sat Yuga there's a hundred percent of the heart. and then in Kali and it goes down... 75%, 50%, to 25%. Now this does not mean that you yourself have only 25% of your heart. This is a generalization of global humanity. Actually from what I've heard from some of my teachers is that what it actually means is that if your heart is really open in Kali Yuga, that is a *far* more powerful thing than when everybody does it. So, to have the heart open in Kali Yuga carries a strength that is exceptional. So this is not saying you only have 25%, but rather it's like a broad brushstroke of where global humanity is at this point. Now the other thing you're bringing up about the Aquarian Dispensation, this actually goes back to sort of mythic history. Many different people in the theosophical and anthroposophical worlds talked about this. Some of the early work on the ... all the **books written in the 1920s**, where they believed that was the beginning of the Aquarius Age then, I've seen those books. They talk about the so-called Aquarian Dispensation, and it goes back to 5-6 thousand years ago. And the idea was that at that time that something like

the caste system, which was based on bloodline, did have a certain essence. There was a certain reality to it, so that if a Brahmana, a Brahmana caste for example, or Plato had his own version of it too. You know Plato believed in the four castes. Also, that individual modeled the best of all the capacities of a human being, it was genuine sovereignty and autonomy and that their main function was to model for humanity those qualities and to serve the people,— very very different than say monarchy or kingship or presidentship or premiership or head of Google, the way that works today. And so, what they knew, what those, the ones that had the purity of the tradition knew, is that it would all fall apart, that it would go into chaos, it would go into darkness and they then had a prophecy that there would be a time period and this is what was called “the Aquarian Dispensation,” when the bloodline of being able to connect with infinity, our sovereignty, and our autonomy would be spread to all of global humanity.”

And this actually was hijacked by the idea that “Oh the return of the Christ...” Like there would be “the return” of the Messiah, the return of the...i mean there's been so many different versions of that. You know, we're waiting for Jesus to return we're waiting for the Maitreya to return, there's different versions of it in different parts of the world. But, what they were saying was “No, it's when *everyone* gets that that's who they are.” So there's no need for Elites, there's no need for philosopher-kings *because* if we know who we really

are, that that's the Aquarian Dispensation, and that's where I've spent so many talks. You've heard most of them, I mean people that follow my work in these vlogcasts and seminars, it's like, "Oh my god, there he goes again talking about the shadow of Aquarius." To me it's the shadow, it's the hijack of Aquarius and preventing people from understanding this aspect of it, then it becomes our connection to spirit, our connection to our god-self, our connection to our christos-sophia soul, you know things like that and that's what I stand for and that that's not the facsimile called A.I.

M - Yeah it's waking up. It's what we talk about is waking up and having these higher-realm realizations, and a lot of the Earth is doing that thank goodness, because I think that there's a as opposed to herd immunity, there is a soul connection that is occurring all over the world, and that love, that power of that love, and that connection is so much stronger than the darkness among us, that that may be the counter-force that we really need.

D- We have to commit ourselves to that. And maybe we can actually close our discussion by saying what is the purpose of our school? The purpose of our school is to assist in the awakening. And on a more personal level, it is to assist human beings to know who they are, and to know their place on the wheel, to know what their life-purpose themes are, know how to fulfill their their intended purpose and then that extends to global humanity. You know

like how can that happen? Well we don't know, I mean it's beyond our control, I mean we don't know what great mystery has in mind, they're stored for us. But our commitment and our school is with the creation of what I like to think of as "Seed People," those who can connect to the magic and the mystery of what has gone before, a remembrance of who we really are, and then being open to look truthfully at what is happening on the planet now to be able to call out evil when evil is there. I mean I'm one of these idealistic people who didn't even, until I read a amazing book called "The War of the Gods and Addiction," when I realized that Jung himself finally realized that "Oh yeah there is archetypal evil." And what is archetypal evil? it's the absence of being human, when you're no longer human then it could become evil, so when we're not connected to the heart or the spirit, and to realize that that needs to be called out, and so there's that, that's the middle-world thing about it. And then the willingness to dream, dream the vision forward. you know we're intenders. "I intend Prime Earth how about you? I intend the sovereignty and the autonomy of the individual. I have a commitment to Human 1.0, that does not seek dominion over over the creation, that does not want to separate. I'm way more interested in being part of the unfolding.

M - I'm with you Daniel and i hope one of our on the ground gatherings is at that primal earth place at some point in the future. That would be beautiful and

D- And just, just an announcement that we will be having a presentation just before the winter before the December Solstice, which will be our normal year look at ahead of the next year, it'll also be kind of a global update and doing a recap on the Saturn-Uranus configuration, which by the way is really right now. We're doing this presentation right with the T-square accented by the Moon position of Mars Saturn-Uranus. So this is an intense passage right now, as Mars is about to come out of the underworld, but then right at the end of the year, there will be a more extended presentation on the Turning of the Ages itself, as we move forward

So thank you for helping me with this and i love doing having you help me out on these you know.
So I know i did most of the talking but I know you were with me on it and until until next month I have no idea what that topic is gonna be at the moment.
