This opening piece on power was part of a personal New Moon ceremony that wrote itself in my journal. At the time I was not aware that the upcoming Chinese New Year on Feb 12, 2002 was the Black Horse. Black Horse Medicine, among other things, is the medicine of power, including the elemental powers of fire (horse) illuminating light and water (black) liquid light. I feel called to offer these images of power as a starting place, as one way to access and inspire the many aspects of our own Power Within, remembering this too is an important element to utilize in our intentional dreaming process.

This Year of the Black Horse is an opportunity to consciously engage Horse medicine for our own personal growth and empowerment process. Mythically, the imagery of the horse often has magical elements linked with it. There is the winged horse Pegasus who connects earth and sky, the magical Unicorns, the mysterious and often rowdy Centaurs to name a few. In stories like Black Beauty by Anna Sewell and The Black Stallion series by Walter Farley these horses are exceptionally beautiful, strong, swift, brave, and intelligent. Some myths describe the huntress Goddess Artemis as having a chariot drawn by Unicorns, Pluto's golden

chariot was drawn by "fiery Black Horses" and Melanippe, known for her hostile encounter with Hercules, was an Amazon warrior whose name means Black Mare. There are indications that King Arthur had a Black Horse Calvary and the Black Horse was also a symbol for the Fifth Century British Calvary. The Black Horse plays many roles in many cultures. Some Native American tribes view the Black Horse as the spirit helper that "travels into the void, the unknown, seeking truth and enlightenment."\*

**Week of Jan 27-Feb 3** This week features a [Full Moon](#) symbolizing the fulfillment, or fruition, of the seeds planted at the New Moon or some earlier

cycle. Once each year the Moon is Full in Leo bringing to light our divine essence. Indeed, we are the radiant and shining ones returning and remembering, activating and radiating a new Golden Age of peace and plenty. As the Hopi Elders remind us, "We are the ones we have been waiting for." The Moon then begins to wane this week representing the dissemination or integration of these gifts.

**Feb 1, Friday.** This month begins with the waning Moon slipping into Libra energizing the sacred mysteries of conscious equal partnership, harmony, and balance. The Moon is crossing Zero Libra a.k.a. the Autumnal Equinox marker in the sky. This cardinal point is currently aligned with the North Galactic Pole lying 90 degrees north of the Galactic Plane looking out into space, near the constellation of Coma Berenices. ([See Sept 2000 CT Archives](#) ) Tuning into this area of the sky enhances our intergalactic connections, and our understanding of time and space. The North Galactic Pole carries a multi-dimensional energy providing a doorway to other realms and galaxies, further facilitating our understanding of how to consciously exist in many realms simultaneously. Accessing the mysteries from this multi-dimensional perspective enhances our ability to consciously dream the dream onward.

**Feb 2, Saturday 02/02/02.** Traditionally celebrated as Candlemas or Imbolc (see Feb 4) this is the time of extinguishing old ceremonial fires and lighting new ones, while celebrating the return of the light symbolized by the lengthening days. The Winter Solstice seeds are stirring and showing signs of growth and for some parts of the world winter is loosening its hold. To what extent is determined by our furry friend the Groundhog. The tradition began in Europe with hedgehogs coming out of their burrows to judge if winter was nearly over. The New World did not have hedgehogs, so groundhogs were adopted, thus the name Groundhog's Day. <http://www.web-holidays.com/candle/>

Checking in with Chiron (7 Capricorn) and Jupiter (almost 6 Capricorn) we find they are moving closer to their exact opposition on the Cancer/Capricorn axis occurring on Feb 9. As the Shamanic Healer, Chiron is acting to collectively heal the societal wounds of the current competitive community model. Jupiter, meanwhile, is expanding this Shamanic Healing process into new territory. Imaging and participating in conscious equal partnership with all those you encounter helps support this process. (See Feb 9)

**Feb 3, Sunday.** Retrograde [Mercury](#) is sliding back into Capricorn until Feb 13. This is further calling our attention to the Capricorn/Cancer axis being activated by Chiron and Jupiter. (See Feb 2 & 9).

What is the message Mercury is bringing us in this process of discovering healthier ways to do family and community? [Starhawk's](#) visionary novel of the future, *The Fifth Sacred Thing*, portrays the clash of two societies: one based on co-operation, diversity, and art, the other on war and domination. In this book Starhawk describes in detail an abundant and peaceful society living in cooperation with each other and the earth, while their neighbors struggle in the old paradigm of competition, domination and war. This book is a great resource for helping to activate our imaginations around the possibilities of living in a truly cooperative society, where resources are shared, and talents and abilities are honored in a way that all the skills of healthy, joyful living are viewed as equal and valid. For example, in this society doctors receive the same compensation as other professions including homemakers and those who raise the children. No one is seen as being more or less important than anyone else. Mercury reminds us that what we envision, imagine and think about is what creates our reality and it is time to consider how to live in a world based on cooperation. The December Celestial Timings stated, "cooperation unifies and strengthens the greater whole, moving us from mere survival into a whole new world of possibilities" limited only by our imagination.

**Week of Feb 4-10** This week marks the [last quarter phase of the Moon](#). In the Hero or Heroine's quest this is the phase of the journey where they cross the return threshold back into the world they left before the journey began, returning with the gifts and boons gained while they were gone. This is the time of the final harvest, where the plant begins its death process, preparing the seeds for the next cycle. As the Moon continues to wane the completion phase of the integration process of the current journey continues and we begin to look at what seeds to plant in the next cycle beginning with the next New Moon in Aquarius on Feb 11/12 which also happens to be the Chinese New Year of the Horse. **Feb 4, Monday.** The exact waning [half full Moon](#) is occurring at 15 Scorpio aligned with the fixed star [Zuben Algenubi](#) and very near the fixed star [Zuben Alshamali](#). These are the two brightest fixed stars of the [Scales](#) representing the balance point between yin and yang, male and female, Heaven and Earth. The Scales also symbolize justice or what just is, and working with the principles of natural law (or cosmic law) and human rules or laws, thus finding the balance and wisdom of how these laws ideally support the full experience of our divinity even in this dense dimension of life. Additionally the Sun is at 15 Aquarius which is the astrological cross-quarter

between Winter Solstice and Spring Equinox, that is now celebrated on Feb 2 as Candlemas or Imbolc. The last quarter Moon also relates to the seasonal energy of Autumnal Equinox. These energies remind us of the importance of balance, of sacred union (cooperation) within ourselves and in our world. When we are in peaceful loving balance within, our world reflects that balance without.

**Feb 5, Tuesday.** The Moon is moving into Sagittarius today emphasizing the quest for truth and meaning. 2001 was an important year for activating deeper awareness around the importance of living, expressing, speaking and being in our truth. Sept 11 played a part in that activation occurring just days before the ending of a 6,000 year timeline in the great pyramid many were calling the [Day of Truth](#). The Moon's movement through Sagittarius supports a deepening investigation into our personal truth. What exactly is our Truth? How has our truth changed, grown and expanded over the past year? Are we consciously living the truth of our being more fully each day? How can we live the fullness of our truth in every moment for the greatest good of all life?

**Feb 6, Wednesday.** The Moon meets with the Shamanic Initiator Pluto taking us further into the truth of our being, pushing us beyond our edges where we can experience and know the pure essence of our truth within ourselves and our world. This is often a scary process because it requires us to enter the unknown where events outside of us are beyond our control. Two important keys are trust and surrender.

**Feb 7, Thursday.** The waning Moon is moving into Capricorn usually signaling an excellent time for getting things accomplished, organized and caught up. However, this just so happens to be coinciding with the direct station of Saturn (8 Gemini) today and the direct station of Mercury (28 Capricorn) tomorrow. When planets station it creates a shift in the energy that often feels chaotic at first and can contribute to unexpected events, delays or detours and any number of other unknown factors coming into play. If this is happening in your world, remember to breathe, meditate and relax whenever possible, letting go of attachments to outcome and trusting the process of change already in motion.

Venus is also conjuncting the revolutionary and unexpected change artist Uranus (24 Aquarius) today adding to the unpredictable nature of this timing.

**Feb 8, Friday.** Mercury stations direct today at 28 Capricorn. This is a good time to remember to roll with the flow and take life as it comes, while attuning

to the magically creative energy, inspiring insights, understanding and wisdom that is culminating as Mercury shifts direction. Remember these energies may be felt for several days before and after today.

**Feb 9, Saturday.** Sometime late today or early tomorrow Jupiter and Chiron oppose one another. Oppositions are similar to a Full Moon effect, when the Sun and Moon are opposite each other. Full Moons are dramatic As Above events illuminating our awareness and inspiring So Below celebrations honoring this monthly cycle. The last time Jupiter and Chiron opposed each other on the Cancer/Capricorn axis was in 1954. In that year we had the famous Supreme Court case Brown vs. the Board of Education where the Supreme Court ruled segregation was unconstitutional paving the way for the eventual desegregation of all public institutions. <http://www.multied.com/dates/1954.html> (See Feb 2 and 3)

**Feb 10, Sunday.** Waning Moon enters Aquarius in the early morning hours, joining with Mercury in the early morning sky illuminating the highly creative, inspired, innovative thinking energies available to us when we give them permission to flow easily through us.

#### **Week of Feb 11 - 19**

The Aquarius [New Moon](#) (24 Aquarius) also signals the Chinese New Year of the Black Horse or Water Horse. <http://www.chinesefortunecalendar.com/2002.htm> For some this is not only the seeding of a monthly Moon cycle, but also of a yearly cycle. This seeding energy includes new, innovative, cutting edge, ideas seeking expression.

**Feb 11, Monday.** The Aquarius [New Moon](#) (24 Aquarius) inspires us to envision and seed the freest possible expression of our true heart's desire. The imagery of the Horse also inspires our imagination into the realms of freedom, travel, and magic. Magic is happening around us all the time. Conscious attention and intention is one way to focus and direct the magical energies seeking expression through us.

**Feb 12, Tuesday.** Venus slipped into Pisces late last night or early this morning, depending on your time zone, where it remains until March 7. The magical feminine (Venus) expressing through Pisces operates in the imaginal realms where we can co-create our world anyway we desire when energizing our heart-felt visions and dreams through passionate imagining.

**Feb 13, Wednesday.** A doorway for more radical changes opens wider today with the Sun/Uranus (25 Aquarius) conjunction illuminating the Uranian

mysteries of unpredictable change facilitating an increasing desire to break out of existing conditions and embrace new exciting pursuits. This yearly Sun/Uranus connection is a New Moon type activation that may feel wildly chaotic while seeding unique possibilities and opportunities. Surrendering, trusting, and going with the flow helps facilitate the changes seeking expression now. It also helps to smooth out the restlessness and anxiety that changes can bring while keeping in mind the changes are designed to promote greater freedom of being.

**Feb 14, Thursday.** Mercury moved back into Aquarius yesterday and then crosses the 15 degree Aquarius mark around Feb 28 where it stationed retrograde last month. Mercury is the transformational messenger and in Aquarius the message comes more easily when we are willing to step back and look at what we are co-creating from the big picture or the cosmic overview. Mercury traveled deeply into these mysteries during its retrograde and is returning with profound insights to share when we are open to them.

**Feb 15, Friday.** Waxing crescent Moon has moved into Aries and will meet with Mars in the western sky tomorrow night. The fiery nature of Moon and Mars in Aries spontaneously calls us to nurture and celebrate the inner child. If possible take time to do something fun and in the moment. Take a hike, see a movie, connect with a friend, or pioneer and explore new territory. The possibilities are only limited by your imagination. Allow your inner child to guide you to a fun, relaxing, exhilarating experience. Remember Mars remains in Aries until March 1, the Moon is going into Taurus on Feb 17. Observing the Moon and Mars tomorrow night you will see how the Moon has moved much closer to Mars. The exact conjunction varies depending on your Time Zone.

**Feb 16, Saturday.** Venus (6 Pisces) representing the Magical Feminine is encountering the potency of her imagination as an important co-creative tool as she travels through the Pisces domain. Now she is trining expansive Jupiter (6 Cancer) who inspires and expands our imagination when it is aligned with our truth. This is a timing that could produce higher than average opportunities for unexpected insights and “aha’s”.

**Feb 17, Sunday.** Waxing Moon moves into Taurus today. These are the mysteries of beauty, intimacy and pleasure as a creative artistic expression. This is a time to remember the art of savoring and enjoying each moment with gratitude for all the abundant gifts and beauty life has to offer. Taurus reminds us to

relax, slow down, and receive, enjoy and savor the sacred pleasures of life as our divine birthright.

**Feb 18, Monday.** Venus (8 Pisces) the Goddess of Love traveling through the Pisces realm is accessing the power of feeling and imagining to manifest our dreams. Today she is squaring Saturn, the wisdom keeper, who in the Gemini domain works with the power of the mind (including imagination) as a potent source for structuring our reality. Two of the most basic elements responsible for co-creating our reality, what we think and what we feel, are being activated by this line up. Aligning our feelings and thoughts with passion and clarity, clearly seeing and declaring our dreams and what we desire to manifest, draws forth this reality from the dreaming realms into concrete structure and form.

**Feb 19, Tuesday.** Sun moved into Pisces yesterday where it remains until March 20. The Pisces realm encourages us to allow our imagination an opportunity to manifest through conscious dreaming. It is not about doing so much as it is about focusing on the dream and claiming it with certainty. When feeling doubts arise it helps to embrace them, express them and then release them, bringing our attention back to the image of the fully realized dream as many times as necessary.

**The week of Feb 20 - 26** The Gemini [First Quarter Moon](#) represents the balance between light and dark. This is the most visible and rapid growth phase of the Moon, crossing the threshold that accelerates whatever process is already in motion. This is the best time of the month to put ideas and plans into action. The Moon continues to increase in light until the Virgo Full Moon on Feb 27.

**Feb 20, Wednesday. 02/20/2002** The Gemini [First Quarter Moon](#) is also occurring during the 10<sup>th</sup> Moon occultation of Saturn since last summer. This one is visible in the United States, Mexico, Central Pacific Ocean, S.E. Canada, north Caribbean and extreme N.W. Africa. The timing of the center point is 7:22 pm EST and 4:22 pm PST. This is coyote energy reminding us to laugh at ourselves, not take anything too seriously and in the process gain deeper insight into who we are, uncovering the hidden beliefs that limit our experience of our reality. Humor and laughter are the healing gifts of the comedian taking us out of ordinary and an often overly serious reality providing the space and opportunity for another level of experience.

**Feb 21, Thursday.** Our largest known asteroid Ceres moves into Pisces late today or early tomorrow, and remains in the Pisces domain until May 14. Ceres has been apart of the collective

awareness since 1801 also enjoying the fact that it was the first asteroid discovered. Ceres is the Roman counterpart to Demeter, both earth mother, fertility goddesses who were preceded by Inanna and Ishtar. Their stories all have in common the descent or journey into the underworld, essentially dying and being reborn. As Ceres passes through Pisces the compassionate mother archetype is strongly emphasized. Tapping into this timing is a good one for connecting with the Compassionate Mother within, lovingly accepting yourself and others, and taking time to nurture yourself imagining how you would have most liked your mother to nurture you. **Feb 22, Friday.** Moon moves into Cancer and occults Jupiter (5 Cancer). This is the second of three Moon Occultations of Jupiter this year and the sixth since last July, 2001. This occultation is occurring opposite Chiron (7 Capricorn) adding to the intensifying energies of the Cancer/Capricorn axis. Jupiter is magnifying the mysteries of responsible nurturing that recognizes the importance of consciously nurturing ourselves before we nurture others. Responsible nurturing is the key to these mysteries. If our self-nurturing is used as a way to avoid or hurt others it is not responsible. Practicing daily self-care, resting when tired, and self-nurturing in gentle, easy, conscious ways, assures our health and vitality so what we have to give comes from wholeness and balance.

**Feb 23, Saturday.** Mercury (8 Aquarius) trines Saturn (8 Gemini). This suggests Mercury is integrating and anchoring its retrograde process while benefiting from concentrated focus in getting organized or completing or beginning projects or practically implement creative revolutionary ideas.

**Feb 24, Sunday.** Moon enters Leo for the next two and half days. When Leo is in its strength and power this energy knows and remembers its radiant and shining divine essence shared by all life. This quote by [Marianne Williamson](#) and a Course in Miracles speaks to a significant essence of the Leo mysteries. "We are born to make manifest the Glory of God that is within us. It's not just in some of us; it's in everyone. And as we let our own Light shine, we unconsciously give other people permission to do the same. As we are liberated from our own fear, our presence automatically liberates others."

Sun (5 Pisces) trines retrograde Jupiter (5 Cancer) alerting us to the slowing of Jupiter and its preparation to turn direct March 1. Following yesterday's trine to Saturn, Mercury now conjuncts Neptune. This combination again speaks to the

practical implementation of revolutionary and visionary ideals.

**Feb 25, Monday.** Venus has been traveling with Sun (in the underworld or otherworld) since December, invisible in either the morning or evening sky. Today for those who have a low horizon, Venus (17 Pisces) is emerging into the evening sky squaring Pluto (17 Sagittarius). This seems fitting as the Queen of Heaven regains her throne completing her underworld experience. How conscious we have been with the Venus underworld process helps determine how easily and gracefully the next phase of the journey unfolds.

**Feb 26, Tuesday.** Sun (8 Pisces) squares Saturn (8 Gemini). Understanding the relationship of the Sun to the outer planets in their yearly direct and retrograde cycles gives us clues about the timing for these planets. This marks the first quarter square of the Sun to Saturn indicating Saturn is picking up speed and accelerating its growth process in the domain of the Saturn in Gemini mysteries (See Feb 20). This is also occurring very near the fixed star Aldebaran, the eye of the Bull and one of the four royal stars that assists us in working with grief, sadness and loss as indicated by *Starlight Elixirs and Cosmic Vibrational Healing* by Michael Smulkis and Fred Rubinfeld <http://hilarion.com/stars.html>. (See Jan 7, 2002 CT archives)

**The week of Feb 27 to Mar 4** This week features the Virgo [Full Moon](#) symbolizing the fulfillment, or fruition, of the seeds planted at the New Moon or some earlier cycle. Each Full Moon reminds us of the seeds we may have coming to maturity, to their fullness, to fruition, to the place where the fruits or gifts are received. The Moon then begins to wane this week representing the dissemination or integration of these gifts. Once each year the Moon is Full in Virgo illuminating the ancient mysteries concerning the patterning of life, and the natural cycles and rhythms that helps us to know what time it is for us and if it is time for unweaving and reweaving our web.

**Feb 27, Wednesday.** This annual Virgo [Full Moon](#) (8 Virgo) is in T-square to Saturn (8 Gemini) drawing upon the expert skills of Spider Woman who weaves new webs when the old ones no longer serve. Saturn asks if the structure and form of our lives supports who we are? The spotlight is on our personal and collective webs. Are the webs we have woven serving our highest expression and experience in life? Is it time to unweave and reweave parts of them, or is it time to weave a whole new more conscious web?

**Feb 28, Thursday.** Within the Full Moon window still in effect today, the Moon is moving into Libra forming a T-square with Jupiter (5 Cancer) and Chiron (7 Capricorn) drawing our attention again to the householder mysteries of home and family, including conscious equal partnership and all the ways partnership supports our evolutionary process in family and community. There was a time when we lived in more tribal settings and banishment from our community usually meant certain death. Over more recent times we have followed a path of individuation. Survival is no longer dependent on tribal connection. And yet, most people would agree that in their heart of hearts they desire a connection to family and community and intimate partnership, even if they only participate with it now and then. Many yearn to feel they belong or fit in some niche of society. These energies are asking us to explore healthy options that heal and support one another in the fulfillment of our divine design.
