

# May 2002 Celestial Timings

**Beltane** marks the cross-quarter between Spring Equinox and Summer Solstice. The above poem describes some of the more current cultural experiences around these energies, though that appears to be changing. The word Beltane means 'bright fire' or 'lucky fire' and in the Celtic seasonal year, Beltane celebrates the start of summer. In the ancient traditions this was a time when all the fires were extinguished on the Eve of Beltane and new fires lit at Beltane sunrise. Often these fires were lit on the hills and in the Standing Stone Circles or Rings found on hilltops. These giant stones are acupuncture needles into the ley lines or meridians of the Earth grid. The Beltane Fires on the Hills are the beacons or points of fire that alchemically activate the energy of the Earth and of ourselves.

Beltane (along with its seasonal opposite point Samhain) was viewed by the ancient Celts as a time when the doorway between the worlds opens. The Samhain doorway allows the ancestors to more easily access our world and the Beltane doorway provides us easier access to the otherworlds if we know how use it. Astrological Beltane occurs around May 5 when the sun reaches 15 degrees Taurus, marking the original Sabbat or high holy day. When the Gregorian Calendar was calculated in the 1500's to account for the precession or movement of equinoxes and solstices through space, Beltane, along with the other cross-quarter dates, was not adjusted to coordinate with the actual astrological cross-quarter. It is also interesting to note that many ancient Celtic traditions began their celebration of Beltane on the Full Moon or New Moon nearest Astrological Beltane, and the celebrations lasted until the next Full or New Moon over a two week period. This year the Scorpio Full Moon was April 26 and the Taurus New Moon is May 12. This two week period covers the Sun's crossing of 15 Taurus and is highlighted by the five planet line-up in the evening sky. These transformative energies further alchemize the potency of this seasonal timing.

This month provides some amazing and spectacular sky watching opportunities...here are some highlights and a website with more information.

*"Such gatherings of the naked-eye planets are relatively rare, occurring roughly every 20 years when slow-moving Jupiter and Saturn appear close together from Earth's perspective. A similar grouping occurred in May 2000, though it was hidden in the Sun's glare. The last compact*

*and widely visible five-planet array was in February 1940, and astronomers calculate that another good one won't take place until September 8, 2040"....*

*"All five visible planets (plus the Moon) will be clustered within 33° of sky on the evening of May 14th. **May 3-7:** Five planets shine in the western sky during evening twilight. Start with bright Jupiter high up; you can't miss it. The rest are bunched together down to Jupiter's lower right. By far the most brilliant of these is Venus. Forming a small triangle with Venus are fainter Saturn and much fainter Mars. The triangle appears nearly equilateral on May 5th. Below the triangle is the star Aldebaran, and to its right is Mercury, which appears farthest from the Sun (21°) on the evening of May 3rd."*

***May 8-12:** All five naked-eye planets continue to be visible. Highest in the sky is brilliant Jupiter. Well to its lower right is even-brighter Venus. Note how the spacing between Venus and dim, orange Mars has shrunk — on May 10th the two appear closest together (just 1/3°, much less than a finger's-width at arm's length). Look below Venus for Saturn. Down to Venus's lower right is Mercury. Binoculars give a great view!*

***May 13:** Go out about 40 minutes after sunset and scan just above the west-northwest horizon for the hairline crescent Moon. Binoculars will help. See if you can spot Mercury a little to the Moon's right, and Saturn to the Moon's upper left. Higher up is dazzling Venus. Barely below Venus, look for faint orange Mars. Jupiter shines much higher up, to Venus's upper left.*

***May 14:** There's a beautiful sight in the west after sunset tonight! The crescent Moon is closely paired with brilliant Venus, the "Evening Star." Just below Venus, look for faint orange Mars; binoculars will help. Farther below is Saturn, and farther lower right of Saturn is Mercury (near the horizon). Well off to the upper left of this whole grouping shines bright Jupiter.*

***May 15:** Look west in twilight for the crescent Moon. To its upper left is bright Jupiter, and farther to its lower right is brighter Venus. Just below Venus is faint little Mars (binoculars help!). Farther down is Saturn.*

***May 16:** The crescent Moon shines in the west this evening, with Jupiter to its lower right. Much farther to their lower right is brilliant Venus.*

**May 17-24:** *The two brightest planets, Venus and Jupiter, are shining in the western sky after dusk and drawing closer together day by day. See if you can spot faint little Mars to Venus's lower right.*

**May 25–31:** *Venus and Jupiter continue to dominate the western sky after dusk. They are becoming more and more eye-catching as they approach a beautiful conjunction (close pairing) on June 3rd. Above them are the much fainter stars Pollux and Castor. Farther to their left is the star Procyon. Farther to their right is bright Capella.*

**Week Of Apr 26-May 3** The Beltane Scorpio [Full Moon](#) occurred on April 26. The Moon is now waning towards its last quarter phase beginning May 4 in Aquarius. Once each year the Moon is Full in Scorpio bringing to light the mysteries of death, rebirth and regeneration.

**May 1, Wednesday.** Sun, near 11 Taurus, is squaring Neptune, near 11 Aquarius, marking the rapid slowing of Neptune in preparation for Neptune's retrograde beginning May 13. Neptune's job is to inspire our connection to "the field of dreams" (a great Neptunian movie) or the field of all possibilities for the purpose of bringing in new visions and dreams. The Sun is illuminating this infinite field of possibilities and there may be feelings of confusion and lack of clarity about what to choose, especially when old patterns and beliefs and ways of operating are still in place or are still in the process of dissolving. The best way to consciously engage these energies is to trust your inner guidance, because external circumstances are often foggy, unclear, and misleading. Neptune teaches the importance of listening to and trusting those inner promptings to successfully navigate the unknown.

**May 2, Thursday,** The Moon changes signs approximately every 2 and ½ days. Tonight the Moon moves from Capricorn to Aquarius, but remains Void of Course in Capricorn most of the day. This is the archetypal energy associated with the elders, the wise and ancient ones, the grandmothers and grandfathers, who know the rules, who know how spirit descends into matter and how to get things done for the greatest benefit and good of all. Moon in Capricorn is usually an excellent time for handling details and getting more organized, however the void of course time is usually not a good time for effective external accomplishment. If you find things are not flowing it is helpful tune into your inner sense of organization and then the outer details will tend to fall more easily into place. In some cases, it may require letting go and coming back to it again another day.

**Week of May 3 – 11** This week marks the [last quarter phase of the Moon](#) in Aquarius. This is the time noted in the seasonal cycle of the final harvest, where the plant begins its death process, preparing the seeds for the next cycle. During this next week the Moon continues to wane, symbolizing the completion phase or integration process

of the current journey. It also signals the time to begin looking at the new seeds to plant in the next cycle beginning with the Taurus New Moon on May 12.

**May 3, Friday.** The Aquarius [last quarter Moon](#) (14 Aquarius) transmits the mysteries of the cosmic revolutionary. This energy is committed to its own unique path of self-expression, questioning what is and not settling for the limitations of the status quo. This is a good time to step back for a good look at the big picture, and make changes where needed.

**May 4, Saturday,** Late last night and early this morning (depending on your time zone) Mars and Saturn came together at 14 Gemini. The activating energy of Mars further catalyzes Saturn's process of shapeshifting and changing forms through stabilizing the new ideas and possibilities that Saturn's journey through the spontaneous and mind stretching domain of Gemini is currently facilitating, taking us beyond the known rules into new territory. Mars is continuing his quest for the sword of truth and the conjunction with Saturn indicates Mars is gathering wise council in the process. This suggests a time of focused concentration, wise discernment and the ability to structure effective ideas and plans in concrete reality, while maintaining a sense of humor and not taking it all too seriously.

**May 5, Sunday.** Tonight be sure to check out the nearly equilateral small triangle formed with brilliant Venus, fainter Saturn and much fainter Mars. We have now reached the astrological cross-quarter known as Beltane when the Sun crosses 15 Taurus. Beltane is a time of maximum fertility, abundance, sacred union, sacred pleasure, and honoring of the Beltane sacred fires through feasting, song, dance, celebration and joy. The month of May and Beltane reminds us life is good, and life is to be celebrated and enjoyed with gratitude. The more grateful we are, the more abundance we attract. Gratitude is like a magnet drawing more of itself to itself.

**May 6, Monday.** The Moon entered Pisces yesterday encouraging us to dream our biggest dreams imaging and or "pretending" that they already exist. Energy follows our thoughts and our words. Imagine it, decree it so with gratitude, and know it is already on its way to manifesting. The final step is to take decisive action that supports the manifestation of your dreams.

**May 7, Tuesday,** Venus and Saturn (14 Gemini) are joined near the western horizon after Sunset. Saturn governs matter as it comes into form. Saturn also represents the wise and ancient ones who know the rules of how things work in third-dimensional reality. Venus is the sacred feminine principle meeting with the wise (and crazy) council of Saturn in the outrageous, coyote, Heyokah energy of Gemini. This Shapeshifter energy reminds us that life is not as 'real' as we often believe and experience. One way to think about this is through our changing perception as we grow and mature. What we think and perceive is continually changing. The perspective and reality of a 7 year old is different than a

14 year, or a 21 year old, or a 50 year old and so on. When mind and matter meet we often experience paradoxes. A book called *Crazy Wisdom*, by Wes Nescar demonstrates this in the following haiku.

*What is Mind?*

*No matter. What is Matter?*

*Never Mind*

**May 8, Wednesday.** Mars (17 Gemini) opposes retrograde Pluto (17 Sagittarius) today. The sacred masculine principle currently on a quest for truth and meaning is encountering the Shamanic Initiator (Pluto) in a powerful opportunity to release all obsessions, beliefs, and fears to facilitate yet another transformation that allows new experiences and ways of being to guide his quest. This is not intended to be the power over others, but rather to connect with and consciously relate to the Power Within in ways that support and celebrate all of life. However, the shadow energies can manifest intensifying the fear elements and the drive to control and dominate each other and our world. Consciously connecting with the Power Within will help guide us through this time as it extends to the next Saturn/Pluto opposition exact again on May 25.

**May 9, Thursday.** Venus (17 Gemini) reaches opposition to retrograde Pluto (17 Sagittarius) and is closing in on her conjunction with Mars tomorrow. The Venus Mars sacred union is visible in the western evening sky after Sunset and will continue to be closely link for the next couple of weeks.

Venus opposite Pluto also adds the element of Shamanic Initiation to the sacred feminine principle bringing her to face to face with her deepest fears so she can transform them into the medicine she carries.

**May 10, Friday.** Venus and Mars (18 Gemini) have reached their exact zodiacal sacred union and are so close together they may appear to touch one another. According to [Sky and Telescope](#) on "May 10th the two appear closest together (just 1/3°, much less than a finger's-width at arm's length)." Mars and Venus are meeting near the fixed star Rigel found in the constellation of Orion. The story goes that Gaia sent, as punishment for Orion's boasting that he would exterminate all the animals on Earth, a mighty scorpion to kill him. The mythic Orion battled briefly with the scorpion who delivered the hunter a deadly sting on the heel, and many believe that Orion's heel is marked by Rigel. This story describes the masculine and feminine principles as being at odds with each other and now there is an opportunity to choose an experience of reunion or healing or restoring between these two principles.

According to Page Bryant in her book *Starwalking* Rigel "embodies the force of pure masculine power" and has the possibility of influencing progress and expanding knowledge. Masculine power is the power of decisive action. Action is one of the components of the threefold creation process. This process is simply stated as thought, word and deed. What we imagine or think, then speak about and act upon is what co-creates our reality. This sacred union of Venus and Mars suggests that committed

action is a key element in the creation of balanced, harmonious conscious equal partnership between masculine and feminine energies (and genders).

**May 11, Saturday.** Moon moved into Taurus yesterday and we are entering the New Moon energies today as the New and Full Moon energies are in effect for three days, the day before, the day of and the day after the New or Full Moon. This is a good time to release and let go of old energies, ideas, beliefs and ways of being and begin to imagine the new energies you are seeding and bringing forth in your awareness in this New Moon window, especially those things that relate to the Taurus mysteries including enjoying and savoring sacred pleasure and beauty as our divine heritage.

**Week of May 12-17** This Taurus [New Moon](#) seed point calls us to savor and enjoy with heart felt gratitude this beautiful garden of Earthly delight and all the abundant gifts we enjoy everyday. New Moons are conception points or seeding points for clearly stating our intentions and/or prayers around our heart's desires allowing them an opportunity to find their highest and best manifestation without attachment to the outcome. As the crescent Moon increases in light, growing bigger each night, it symbolizes the growth of the seeds planted at the New Moon.

**May 12, Monday.** The Taurus [New Moon](#) (22 Taurus) inspires us to seed our truest heart's desires for Heaven on Earth. Imagining "the garden" of abundance, of beauty, of sensual sacred pleasure, where our hearts sing with gratitude for the gifts of life, love and joy. These are some of the possible seeds worth energizing and nurturing in this New Moon.

Later today the Moon enters Gemini, energizing the mysteries of the Heyokah, Coyote, Contrary, Shapeshifter, Magician. Gemini is the eternal youth, free from the rules, reminding us not to take ourselves too seriously. This is a good time to play, go to a party, socialize, network, or do something completely spontaneous, creative and fun.

**May 13, Monday.** Neptune stations retrograde at 11 Aquarius and Mercury is slowing to station retrograde May 15. Neptune remains retrograde until Oct 20. This is a time to allow the inner visions and dreams space and recognition without necessarily acting upon them at this time. The inner incubation time is important and knowing when to intuitively act is a part of the Neptunian process. Even projects already in motion may be up for some quiet reflection and revisioning.

**May 14, Tuesday.** Today we may be in for a wild ride with three Moon occultations accelerating the energy of Saturn (15 Gemini visible in UK, Norway and Arctic) Mars (21 Gemini visible in South America), and Venus (24 Gemini visible in the South Pacific Ocean). The definition of "occult" is rooted in Old English, Greek, and Old German words that mean concealed, covered, hidden and secret, and is associated with the supernatural. Astronomical speaking the definition of occultation means "covered." Occultations like eclipses accelerate change. Three occultations in one day is a triple acceleration worth

conscious attention and intention. Hidden or secret aspects within our 3-Dimensional structure, the sacred feminine and the Sacred Masculine principles are being covered and uncovered within about a two hour time period for each occultation. In the mystery school of Gemini there is an indication that this takes us beyond ordinary reality, beyond the rules of this dimension, beyond rational and linear thought processes. Letting go of pre-conceived ideas and beliefs and paying attention to the energies as they are presenting themselves is one way to consciously participate with this timing.

This also marks the passage of Venus (a.k.a. Inanna) through the third gate out of the underworld where she retrieves a healthy relationship with her own personal power.

**May 15, Wednesday.** [Mercury](#) stations retrograde (10 Gemini) today near the fixed star Aldebaran, the eye of the bull. Aldebaran and Saturn have been closely linked this past year. The transformational messenger (Mercury) is passing by this star three times in its retrograde creating an opportunity for us to witness behind the scenes mysteries, including knowledge of how the magician actually creates magic. Opening to receive the messages without preconceptions allows for the greatest magic possible to occur.

Mercury stations direct in about three weeks on Jun 8 at 1 Gemini. This three week period is a great timing for engaging right-brained creative activities, doing inner healing processes, and for completing projects already in motion. It is always wise to make sure you have a current back-up for you computer at these times and allow extra time for left brained type communication processes to take place.

**May 16, Thursday.** Moon has moved into Cancer and is moving to conjunct Jupiter. Jupiter is making its final zodiacal alignment with the fixed star Sirius in its travels through the Cancer domain and won't return to this area of the sky for about another 12 years. (See May 17 & 18) This activates the power of three via the Moon and its ability to transmit the mysteries of the Cancer lineage, and Jupiter and its ability to expand the initiating energies of Sirius also linked with the mysteries of the [Great Pyramid](#) and other ancient temples through astronomical alignments. According to M. Temple Richmond's book on Sirius it is "the Great Star of Initiation" The author also gives this advice, "Let us, therefore, enter humbly and reverentially into meditative contemplation of Sirius, the custodian of occult mystery, for in contemplating this great star-being, we encounter a sacred source of transcendence." This star also supports us in creating physical transformation. (See May 17) Now is a great time to sit in meditative relationship with Jupiter, the Moon and Sirius and open to receive insights or messages about your own personal transformational process.

**May 17, Friday.** Jupiter makes its last exact zodiacal alignment with Sirius tomorrow. This event will not occur again for approximately 12 years. Jupiter magnifies and expands and initiates a renewal of vision and linked with Sirius the possibilities are limited only by our imaginations. Sirius is the brightest fixed star in the sky apart from our

Sun. It has been known as "The Scorcher" or "The Shinning One" with an ability to make the mundane sacred, and to make the ordinary charismatic. This star is located at the mouth of the constellation known as Canis Major or the Greater Dog.

<http://www.winshop.com.au/anne/alphabet1.htm> Tuning into this area of the sky and meditating on this star can help to shift our vibration according to the book *Starlight Elixirs and Cosmic Vibrational Healing* by Michael Smulkis and Fred Rubinfeld <http://hilarion.com/stars.html> They also indicate that the underlying message of Sirius is the immediate importance of transformation of the physical body. Tuning into this star and asking for support in this transformational process is magnified by the zodiacal alignment of Jupiter. There is no better time than now!!(See May 16) Note Retrograde Mercury is now disappearing disappears from the evening sky. Shamanically this symbolizes Mercury's journey into the underworld to begin its transformation into a whole new archetype.

**May 18, Saturday,** Saturn and Pluto are moving closer and closer to their exact opposition on May 25. These energies along with many other spectacular events that have occurred in the past few weeks and months have been busily rewiring our life here on planet Earth at a deep cellular level. Remembering to rest and replenish ourselves daily, exercising, spending time in nature, taking time to renew our spirits in whatever ways that work best for us, drinking lots of pure living water for maximum physical hydration and continued purification, taking time to embrace our deepest feelings and releasing them with love and forgiveness (when necessary) helps smooth out the integration of these deep physical changes.

**Week of May 19 - 25.** The Leo [First Quarter Moon](#) is found directly overhead on May 19. This is the most visible growth phase of the Moon (literally) and the best time to put our ideas and plans into action. As the week progresses the Moon waxes or gains in light until reaching its full phase in Sagittarius on May 26.

**May 19, Sunday.** The Leo First Quarter Moon (29 Leo) is very near the fixed star Regulus, marking the heart of the Lion. The Lion constellation is linked to the Sphinx and "The Hall Of Records". In his book [Fingerprints of the Gods](#), Graham Hancock pointed out that the First Time date of 10,500 BCE also denoted the beginning or First Time of the Age of Leo. This was when the Lion constellation would have risen heliacally (at dawn before the sun) on the day of the vernal (spring) equinox. This event brought the celestial lion to rest due east, thus in perfect alignment with the Sphinx. The Sphinx, in other words, was made to look at his own image in the horizon - - and consequently at his own "time." The First Quarter Moon phase occurring so close to Regulus accelerates our conscious memory of the codes or records linked with the Sphinx. The constellation of the Lion in the Great above is reflected by the Sphinx in Egypt in the Great Below reminding us of the divine codes we all carry within ourselves. It is time to remember our divine nature and that we are the radiant and shining ones returning to walk

the earth once again. As the Hopi Elders remind us, "We are the ones we have been waiting for."

**May 20, Monday.** Venus moves into Cancer crossing the June Solstice Cardinal marker in the sky. Venus remains in Cancer until June 15. The Great Goddess Venus has moved into the archetypal realm of the Great Mother who knows not only how to nurture her children and family, but also how to nurture herself so that she remains balanced and able to more effectively nurture others.

**May 21, Tuesday.** Sun moved into Gemini late last night or early this morning depending on your time zone where it remains until the June 21 Solstice. The Sun is now illuminating the mischievous Gemini mysteries reminding us not to take ourselves too seriously and to play and have fun. Moon is Void of Course most of the day before moving into Libra late afternoon or evening. This is a time to surrender outcome and go with the flow as many will find challenges in getting things going or making things happen in the outer world during this timing.

**May 22, Wednesday.** The waxing Moon moved into Libra late yesterday calling attention to the mysteries of conscious equal partnership in all our relationships. This is the archetype of the diplomat who is willing to listen to all sides, to all the parts and threads of the tapestry, weaving together an understanding designed to support the needs of all the parts. Thus the truth of all parts is acknowledged and honored and then we naturally live in right relationship, peace, harmony, and balance with all life.

**May 23, Thursday.** Moon moves into Scorpio late today or tonight. The Scorpio mysteries include death and rebirth, resurrection and renewal, and empowerment through the Shamanic Journey that calls us to face the fears that disempower us. It is helpful to surrender to divine will, aligning personal will with divine will for the purpose of mastering the art of magic and manifestation. This requires personal sacrifice or the willingness "to make sacred" through surrender to the divine.

**May 24, Friday.** The North Node (17Gemini51) is moving to conjunct Saturn (16Gemini25) and the South Node (17Sagittarius51) is moving to conjunct Pluto (16Sagittarius37). Note that Pluto and Saturn are nearly exact and will be exactly opposite one another tomorrow. The nodes represent the collective time track of humanity and their alignment with Pluto and Saturn suggest a Shamanic Process of restructuring humanities destiny in a major way. What do we need to surrender or unplug from in the old paradigm or matrix? These next few months continue to activate this process. It is not until Aug that the South Node makes its exact conjunction to Pluto. Are we willing to let go of what we know? It might be helpful to revisit the movie "The Matrix" as a teaching about the process of unplugging from the current fear-based matrix.

**May 25, Saturday.** Today marks the last exact opposition of Pluto and Saturn, though we will likely feel the effects of this encounter for some weeks yet to come. Pluto initiations require a surrender to what needs to die and Saturn is the matrix or structure of our current reality. It is

time to die to what has been and create the space for new energies and ways of being to emerge. In the movie "The Matrix", this process does not take place over night, but requires conscious choice and willingness to face the limitations the fears represent. The main character in the movie Neo, "the One", finally masters his reality near the end of movie. He literally is no longer at the effect of what appears to be reality, but is able to direct his own experience.

**May 26, Sunday.** There is a Full Moon Penumbral Lunar Eclipse at 5 degrees of Sagittarius occurring in the early morning hours, visible in North America in all areas except the northeast. Also visible in Central America, Western South America, extreme Northeastern Russia, eastern Asia, Australia, most of Antarctica, the Pacific Ocean, and the southeast Indian Ocean, according to Jim Maynard's Celestial Guide 2002. As if this month did not already contain a plethora of activating and accelerating celestial events, we have yet another to add to the mix. Staying present with the truth of our being and allowing the new energies to find healthy, loving expression through us helps to expand the possibilities beyond what has been previously known.

**May 27, Monday.** The Moon entered Capricorn on Monday and has been transmitting the mysteries that teach us how to more effectively administrate the domain of our earthly life. When in balance the Capricorn mysteries operate with awareness of how our actions effect the next seven generations and how we can contribute to the health and well being of our personal and collective environment.

**May 28, Tuesday.** Mars moves into Cancer Mars activating the June Solstice point already activated by Venus earlier this month. Mars is in his current quest for truth and wholeness. The external truth is always changing as our perception changes. What we perceive as truth today may not be true for us tomorrow. The quest is to understand the nature of truth within and without, in its many different forms and non-forms. These next several months provide an opportunity to discover the meaning behind the old saying "The truth shall set you free." Remember, the Mars quest includes the sword of truth that cuts through the illusions that bind us to a limited reality.

**May 29, Wednesday.** For most of the day we have a Void of Course Moon until it enters Aquarius tomorrow. The Void of Course Moon is a time when external events can go awry. Today is not a good day to start new projects. There are often unknown factors at work at this time so decisions made now may not develop as planned. If at all possible today is a time for inner attention and focus. If at all possible it is better to put off decisions and plans until tomorrow.

**May 30, Thursday.** The waxing Moon enters Aquarius bringing through the mysteries of the cosmic revolutionary who experiments with innovative ideas intended to accelerate growth and consciousness. This is a good time to question the rules and structure of your life and find

where they are limiting and restrictive. Invite the changes that support your freest expression of who you truly are.

**May 31, Friday.** The Moon meets with Neptune today moving on to catch up with Uranus late tomorrow or early the next day.
