

The Hindu New Year known as Diwali (*Du-vah-ly* the festival of lights) begins the Month with the Scorpio New Moon. Some believe this holiday celebrates the union of Lakshmi and Vishnu thus this is also a time for honoring and celebrating the Goddess of Love, Wealth and Beauty a.k.a. Lakshmi or Mahalakshmi. Maha means great. <http://diwalimela.com/customtraditions/> http://members.tripod.com/~jennifer_polan/diwali.html (See Nov 2004 Celestial Timings Archives) This is also the time of **All Saints Day**, a Roman Catholic observance honoring their Saints who already reside in Heaven. Also in the Catholic tradition Nov 2 is **All Souls Day** reminding souls here to live a holy life and to pray for the souls lost in purgatory. In more ancient traditions Nov 2 honors the Dead. In Mexico and parts of the Western United States, Dia de los Muertos or the *Day of the Dead* dates back at least 3,000 years and has even survived the Spanish Conquistadors attempts over 500 years ago to eradicate this Meso-American tradition. Many other cultural traditions have also used this seasonal timing, when the plants are dying and preparing their seeds for rebirth, to honor and remember the ancestors, those who have died, and all who have come before. It is a time for celebrating and recognizing the cycle of death as an important part of the cycle of life.

The ancient Celts celebrated this cross-quarter time as their New Year's point called Samhain usually on the New or Full Moon closest to the astrological cross-quarter on Nov 7. This Samhain cross-quarter is when the veils between all the worlds, especially the world of the living and the world of the dead, are thinnest. The Celts believed this timing was most powerful for looking into the future and for accessing other worlds more easily. This was (and is) a time to go within and seek guidance from the ancestors for the coming year. This was celebrated as a night of High Magic for those attuned to the mysteries, celebrating death and rebirth, endings and beginnings, and that which is yet to come. It was also believed that this timing when worked with consciously helped to set the pattern for the coming year.

The Jupiter in Scorpio article I sent last week is now posted on the Articles page. With Mars retrograde in Taurus, Saturn's recent move into Leo and Chiron returning to Aquarius to join with Neptune already at mid-degrees of Aquarius we have an interesting Grand Fixed Cross moving in and out of close alignment over the next few weeks. Especially when the Moon passes through these Fixed signs. The easiest way to gracefully move through these energies is to do whatever it takes to fully love your glorious divine self with as much joy and passion as possible.

November Sky Highlights On Nov 6 and 7 **Mars** reaches opposition to the Sun beginning a new Mars cycle that will last 26 months and it just so happens Mars is the brightest it will be until 2018. Mars is visible above and to the right of the Pleiades rising as the Sun sets and setting as the Sun rises the next day. Although Mars is in one of its brightest appearances **Venus** is nearly twice as bright setting about two and half hours after Sunset on Nov 1 and three hours after Sunset by month's end. Mars will also be visible in the daytime fifteen minutes before the Sun sets on Nov 14 about 3 to 4 degrees to the Moon's lower left. **Venus** is also visible two hours before Sunset 2 to 3 degrees to the Moon's upper right on Nov 5 and is traveling through the constellation of the Archer (also called the Teapot by modern day astronomers). As the month begins Venus is crossing Galactic Center and approaching the tip of the arrow near a star called **Spiculum** a Latin word for dart or point of an arrow or similar weapon. By Nov 19 Venus reaches the end of the arrow near a fixed star called Nunki. **Mercury** is visible with binoculars or a telescope near Antares and to the

lower right of Venus the first week of November. The tiny crescent **New Moon** will pass by Mercury, Antares and Venus Nov 3, 4, and 5. **Jupiter** rises 15 degrees south and to the lower left of Spica in the morning sky as the month begins and by Nov 8 all three Mars, Jupiter and **Saturn** are visible before dawn. The waning **Moon** passes by Saturn on Nov 21 and Jupiter on Nov 28.

Night Sky Highlights

November 1st: New Moon 8:25pm EST

November 5th: Venus and the crescent Moon are paired in the southeastern sky at dusk.

November 6th: Mars is at opposition tonight. It is positioned opposite the Sun and is shining practically at its brightest, all night long.

November 8th: First Quarter Moon at 8:57pm EST.

November 14th: Mars shines fiery yellow below the Moon this evening.

November 15th: Full Moon at 7:57pm EST.

November 21st: Saturn shines to the right of the Moon after they rise late this evening.

November 23rd: Last Quarter Moon at 5:11pm EST.

November 28th: In the early dawn, the waning crescent Moon hangs in the southeast with Jupiter to its lower left and fainter Spica to its upper right.

November 29th: Jupiter shines above the crescent Moon low in the southeast sky during early dawn.

Tuesday, November 1st: Today is All Saint's Day, an universal Christian feast that honors and remembers all Christian saints, known and unknown. In Portugal and France people offer flowers to dead relatives. In Poland, the tradition on this day (known as Zaduszki) is to light candles and visit the graves of deceased relatives. Catholics in the Philippines spend the day visiting the graves of deceased relatives, where they offer prayers, lay flowers, and light candles, often in a picnic-like atmosphere.

Today is the New Moon (9 Scorpio) at 8:25 pm EST. Traditionally, the New Moon is a time to plant new seeds to bring to fruition at the Full Moon. The chart of the New Moon is the key to influences in the coming lunar month. The Scorpio Moon is conjunct Jupiter (01 Scorpio) and the Sun (10 Scorpio). The trinity of the Sun, Moon and Jupiter in Scorpio brings energy to the illumination of women's mysteries and the feminine divine. The most loved and most feared archetype is the Mother Goddess, especially the Dark Mother Goddess. Take the opportunity of this lunar cycle to discover the role of the feminine divine in your life.

Wednesday, November 2nd: The Scorpio Moon is opposite Mars (17 Taurus). Explore the feminine through the relationship between the Scorpio goddess and the

Taurean god. The Scorpio goddess is the Sorceress Witch, Shamaness, and Tantrika who works to master feelings in order to manifest will into matter. The goddesses associated with Scorpio are Kali, Pele, Hecate, and Sekmet. The Taurean god explores the balance of giving and receiving and the capacity for intimacy and savoring life at the deepest level.

Thursday, November 3rd: The Moon enters Sagittarius at 8:55am EST. The Sagittarius Moon is conjunct Mercury (5 Sagittarius). The Sagittarian goddess is the truth-seeker. She is on a quest for the meaning of life. The energy of Mercury will aid her in speaking the truth of life, hers and yours if you allow her to help you bring your quest for your spiritual truth.

Friday, November 4th: The Moon continues in Sagittarius, continuing the opportunity for fully expanding yourself in search for the meaning of life. Use her energy to access your adventurist spirit and go boldly where you have never gone before.

Saturday, November 5th: The Moon enters Capricorn at 1:17pm EST. Venus enters Capricorn at 3:11am EST. The Capricorn Moon is conjunct Venus (01 Capricorn). Capricorn's aspects of the feminine divine include "The Queen Bee", "The Matriarch", and "Wise Woman." The Matriarch and the Wise Woman are required to know the rules for the community and to ensure that the community is responsibly administered.

Sunday, November 6th: The Moon continues in Capricorn. Take this time to explore your relationship with the Wise Woman in your life. Are you accessing the wisdom that she has to offer? Are you paying attention to your inner Wise Woman?

Monday, November 7th: The Moon enters Aquarius at 4:31pm EST. The Aquarian goddess is independent and revolutionary. Use her energy to experiment and explore different paths to spiritual truth. The Moon (16 Aquarius) enters the First Quarter Phase at 8:57pm EST. The First Quarter Moon, when the Moon is square the Sun, is the beginning of the second phase of the current lunar cycle. This is the time to focus on making the necessary changes so that the opportunities offered during this cycle can be fully integrated. The patterns set at the First Quarter, whether growth-oriented or unproductive, will continue to develop throughout the current lunar cycle. The Sun (16 Scorpio) is opposite Mars (15 Taurus) illuminating the tantric path of savoring life and appreciating the beauty of all living beings.

Tuesday, November 8th: The Moon continues in Aquarius and is opposite Saturn (11 Leo) and conjunct Neptune (15 Aquarius). Saturn can cause dissatisfaction with the status quo and Neptune can cause confusion and lack of clarity about the current "truth." These conditions will enhance and energize the opportunities presented by the Aries Moon to find our spiritual truth.

Wednesday, November 9th: The Moon enters Pisces at 7:22pm EST. The Piscean goddess' gift is the ability to merge with others, feel their feelings and provide the love and understanding that is needed. She is the Nurse-Caregiver, the Empathic Woman, the Bodhisattva, and the Mystical Dreamer.

Thursday, November 10th: The Moon continues in Pisces and is conjunct Uranus (7 Pisces). Uranus will provide unpredictable, unplanned and uncontrollable events that will help you to tap into your ability to be selfless, giving and empathic.

Friday, November 11th: The Moon enters Aries at 10:22pm EST. The Aries goddess is foot-loose and fancy-free. She is whole and complete unto herself and determines her own course of action for her life. She is the "Virgin Amazon" whose identity is based on her own accomplishments and achievements and not dependent upon with whom she is affiliated.

Saturday, November 12th: The Moon continues in Aries. The Moon is square Venus (7 Capricorn). The energies of the Amazon and the Wise Woman/Matriarch bring the wisdom and opportunities to develop your identity based on your own accomplishments and achievements.

Sunday, November 13th: The Moon continues in Aries. The Aries goddess is the "Wild Woman." Are you in tune with your inner Wild Woman? What would she do that you aren't doing because of fear or other reasons? Read the book, "Women Who Run With Wolves", to figure out what it means for you to truly be free.

Monday, November 14th: The Moon enters Taurus at 2:02am EDT. The Taurean goddess is associated with Aphrodite, who represents the qualities of deep personal intimacy. She is autonomous in selecting partners for deep personal intimacy. She has high standards and requirements for intimacy and no one can be with her unless her standards are met. Mercury stations retrograde at 12:42am EST. The Moon is opposite Jupiter (4 Scorpio) at 9:23am EST and conjunct Mars (13 Taurus) at 11:43pm EST. Jupiter and Mars expand and energize opportunities to be completely in the current of life and to increase your life force energy. The purpose is to learn how to transmute will into matter for the sole purpose of enjoyment.

Tuesday, November 15th: The Moon (23 Taurus) enters the Full Moon phase at 7:57pm EST. The Full Moon illuminates the seed and potential of the New Moon. If a positive attitude of growth has developed and the restrictions of the past were thrown off during the waxing Moon, then the Full Moon can now bring fulfillment and a renewed sense of determination and resolve. However, if a negative attitude has dominated the period of increasing light, then the Full Moon can bring conflict. Uranus (7 Pisces) stations direct at 7:08pm EST. The Moon is opposite the Sun (24 Scorpio) at 7:57pm EST. The New Moon seed of the Scorpio goddess is brought to fruition by the Full Moon Taurean goddess completing the circuit of life force creation and regeneration. Did seeds you planted at the New Moon come to completion at the Full Moon?

Nov 16, Wednesday. The shapeshifter coyote trickster mysteries are being transmitted by the Moon in Gemini and with radical revolutionary Uranus (7 Pisces) having stationed direct yesterday and Mercury (11 Sagittarius) the day before that...it is a good time to remember to expect the unexpected and roll with flow. Unusual messages that take us in new directions shifting our entire perspective on reality are also possible.

Nov 17, Thursday. Mars (11 Taurus) Trines Venus (11 Capricorn) and both are visible in the evening sky. This means the sacred masculine (Mars) has visual connection with this accomplished and confident goddess (Venus) inspiring his new quest for beauty and sacred pleasure even though they do not actually meet before Venus leaves the evening stage in January. This may feel frustrating to the Taurus God who does not meet up with the Goddess until mid-October of 2006 in the underworld where they are both undergoing powerful initiations.

Nov 18, Friday. The Moon moves into Cancer later today reminding us to nurture ourselves and our dreams with loving tender care in ways similar to nurturing a growing child. Also today retrograde Mars is square nearly retrograde Saturn (11 Leo and going retrograde on Nov 22). Mars and Saturn will square off again on Dec 27 staying within a tight range of each other from now until then. This is a great opportunity to acknowledge, express and then release control, denial, frustration, anger and other denied or repressed emotions that prevent our inner masculine (Mars) from full on healthy expression. Also during this time Jupiter in Scorpio is opposing Mars and squaring Saturn expanding the energies and the potential for expressing full on passion for life in healthy, dynamically successful ways. (See Jupiter In Scorpio Article)

Nov 19, Saturday. About an hour after sunset in the SW sky Venus (14 Capricorn) is visible near the fixed star Nunki (12 Capricorn) in the constellation of the Archer. The [Fixed Star Site](#) says Nunki is...a star in the vane of the Arrow on the Archer's hand in [Sagittarius](#) (a.k.a the Archer). And is "the Star of the Proclamation of the Sea", or the "Voice from the Sea" [indicating direction, guidance,

instruction], and portended favorable events for mariners and shipping. Star Light Elixirs and Cosmic Vibrational Healing by Michael Smulkis and Fred Rubenfeld <http://hilarion.com/stars.html> describe Nunki as "A star directly seeded by the center of the galaxy" with a direct connect "to the nexus of information, wisdom and awareness" emanating from the galactic center where creative force originates stimulating "a new contextual view, a new idea, or a remembrance of an old idea now brought into form in a new way." Visual intentional connection with Venus and Nunki (also known as Pelagus) enhances direct access to this doorway of energy.

Nov 20, Sunday. Retrograde Mercury (7 Sagittarius) is again squaring Uranus (7 Pisces) indicating the potential for radical messages designed to shift the assemblage point of our current reality? The last time this aspect will take place in the context of this retrograde cycle is Dec 18, 2005. With the Moon now in Leo the question might be...Can we truly embrace the message of the Hopi Elders who remind us "We are the Ones we have been waiting for"?

Nov 21, Monday. Today the Sun moves into Sagittarius where it remains until Dec 21. These are the final synthesizing energies of the current yearly cycle. Sagittarius synthesizes all the experiences, all the proclamations of truth and meaning, all that feels and is true, and wisely disregards the rest. Today the waning Leo Moon is conjunct stationary (goes retrograde tomorrow) Saturn (11 Leo) visible low on the eastern horizon before sunrise. Saturn in Leo is asking if the structure of your life reflects self-love? If not, how can you restructure your life in a way that is loving and supportive to you?

Nov 22, Tuesday. Saturn (11 Leo 19) stations retrograde today reaching the center Still Point that occurs when any planet shifts direction. This is where we can access all possibilities when we are willing to be still and tune in. Saturn moved into the sign of Leo Jul 15, 2005 and became a morning star on Aug 11, 2005. Today, still appearing as a morning star, Saturn's retrograde begins a journey that lasts until April 4, 2006 (when Saturn stations direct at 4Leo22) designed to deepen our personal and collective experience in reformulating healthy expressions of the inner divine glory that we all carry. The shadow sides of Leo include those who believe "I am special and you are not" as well as those who do not love who they are and are afraid to truly show up and shine in the full radiance of their divinity with the intent to empower others to do the same. From now until April we have a great opportunity to reformulate structures of belief that may be holding us back and to build new structures that easily support authentic expressions of our true radiant divine nature? Practices that support genuine self-love are especially helpful.

Nov 23, Wednesday. The [last quarter phase of the Moon](#) is exact today at 2 Virgo. This return threshold crossing indicates a degree of mastery attuned to the natural cycles and patterns within the web of life. Spider Woman weaves the pattern...connecting the knowledge of the past with

the possibilities of the future. ..." Especially when we are willing to dream and vision and reweave our existing web or even weave a whole new more consciously placed and intended web when needed. ...Notice that the web constantly grows, outward, still connected to that small center space. It is always reaching, always expanding, never satisfied with the status quo. When something of value gets caught in the web, it is taken back to that small center and utilized; never wasted. It may be stored for later use, but it is never wasted." [Spider Medicine](#) It might be helpful to try ceremonially drawing your own Spider Web...using an eight pointed star and connecting the lines while imaging and placing your intent into the forming web. You might even want to write words, or phrases in or around the web and place it on your altar as a reminder of the intent you are attracting to your personal web. Remember, a well placed web attracts all that is needed to thrive.

Nov 24, Thursday. The Sun conjuncts Mercury (2 Sagittarius 40) marking the beginning of a new Mercury cycle over the next three months that explores how we recognized, perceive, and communicate the truth of our being. When considering that Mercury stationed retrograde in alignment with the fixed star Antares, the heart of the Scorpion, we can add to this exploration of truth an intention that our knowing of the truth originates in the heart and not just in the mind. (See Nov 30)

Nov 25, Friday. The Moon is moving into Libra late tonight traveling through the constellation of the Virgin Priestess passing by the fixed star [Spica](#) on Nov 27. [Spica](#) and [Arcturus](#) travel through heavens together and are now visible in the morning sky about 90 minutes before sunrise. Each has their own function and importance as well as their connection to each other... And over the past few months Jupiter, Venus and Mercury have passed by here. Spica has links to many of the major Goddess figures throughout recorded time. Arcturus is known as the faithful guardian and protector of the goddess and also has connections with King Arthur whose sword of truth was designed to lead the people to freedom and victory. Which it did... until Arthur forsook his pledge to Avalon, the Lady of the Lake, the Ancient Ones, and the Holy Regalia (including Excaliber and the Holy Grail). This action led to the downfall and disappearance of Camelot, with Avalon vanishing into the mist. This story describes the split between the world of magic and the world of form while also prophesizing they would one day be reunited. It is now time to reclaim what was lost, consciously bringing the world of magic out of the mists of our awareness while passing the mantle of new awareness onto what is currently birthing during this turning of the great wheel of time.

Nov 26, Saturday. Retrograde Mercury (went retrograde Nov 13/14) is moving back into Scorpio stationing direct at 24 Scorpio on Dec 3 and returning to Sagittarius on Dec 12. Transformational messenger Mercury in Scorpio deepens the quest for truth, relentlessly revealing what is necessary to transform the old limiting beliefs that have bound us into a tightly constrained matrix of experience. It is time for the old limiting matrix to die. A smooth transition

is possible when we willingly surrender. If we are trying to control the outcome the external events become increasingly intense and beyond our ability to direct or manage. A helpful strategy is to trust, accepting what IS beyond our control and then surprisingly great magic, beyond what we have ever imagined, can and does manifest.

Nov 27, Sunday. Expansive Jupiter (7 Scorpio) is trining radically revolutionary Uranus (7 Pisces) increasing opportunities for sudden assemblage point shifts that expand understanding and awareness in unusual ways. (See Nov 28) The waning Moon is approaching Jupiter (7 Scorpio) reaching exact conjunction tomorrow visible in the morning sky near the fixed star Khambalia... Eric Morse author of *The Living Stars*: suggests this star has connections with *secret knowledge...and is a symbol for 'the secret of life'... as well as a means to enter a transcendental state of consciousness.* This supports the integration of imagination and dreaming within the field of all possibilities for the purpose of creating a new mythos (meaning the pattern of basic values and attitudes we carry as a culture) through the "secret knowledge" encoded within the emerging mythos that is designed to guide our life experience.

Nov 28, Monday. Still within the effect of the Jupiter Uranus trine from yesterday we have the Sun (7 Sag) squaring Uranus (7 Pisces) today indicating Uranus is picking up speed since its direct station earlier this month. (see Nov 15 and 16) These energies illuminate ideas and information that challenge the accepted status quo often manifesting through surprises and/or reversals that challenge our perception of what is real. When this occurs it is an assemblage point shift or a shift around the core beliefs and attitudes that organize our experience of reality. When we allow for all the possibilities and ways of being, especially the ones that are radically unconventional and cosmically inspired, our relative world expands producing liberating experiences of evolutionary growth.

Nov 29, Tuesday. Pluto has spent the greater part of this year passing by the fixed star [Ras Alhague](#) in the constellation known as Ophiuchus and has just passed beyond the one degree orb of this important star. The Sun however is now passing through Ophiuchus and will conjunct Rasalhague on Dec 13. Mercury is also spending additional time in Ophiuchus this year due to its Retrograde passing by Ras Alhague on Dec 29. This star is known for its desire to heal wounds and is strongly connected to the concept of healing, whether on a personal level or in society as a whole.

[The Fixed Star Site](#) has extensive information about Ophiuchus worth noting...This constellation is positioned between the Archer stretching from just east of the head of Hercules to the Scorpion; partly in the Milky Way, divided nearly equally by the celestial equator; but, although always shown with the Serpent, the catalogues have its stars entirely distinct from the latter. The classisists, however, united the two figures into a single constellation. [Serpens](#) (the snake) and Ophiuchus (the

snake holder) are often considered together. *Serpens itself is a two section constellation; divided into head and body by the intervening Ophiuchus.* [SLM p.297]. Although this constellation is not considered one of the zodiacal twelve, Mr. Royal Hill writes: "Out of the twenty-five days, from the 21st of November to the 16th of December, which the sun spends in passing from Libra (the Scales) to Sagittarius (the Archer), only nine are spent in the Scorpion, the other sixteen being occupied in passing through Ophiuchus". Thus, according to his idea of the boundaries, this actually is more of a zodiacal constellation than is the Scorpion. [SLM].

However Signs and Constellations are two different things. A constellation is a specific grouping of stars. The so called Zodiacal signs are based on the Solstice and Equinox points and the seasonal passage of the Sun through the sky divided into twelve signs or twelve equal divisions of the circle in space. (See [The Difference Between Signs and Constellations](#))

Ophiuchus is Aesculapius, the ancient healer, believed to be the ancestor of Hippocrates (born 460 BCE) the great physician of Cos, and Serpens was his symbol of healing. The serpent as depicted in the caduceus is the symbol for the poison (venom) that can both cure and kill, and Ophiuchus uses it to heal. The cult of Aesculapius began in Thessaly, temples were built throughout Greece, especially near healing springs. After fasting and bathing, the sick and disturbed would spend the night in special 'dream incubation chambers' in his temples. The god, appearing to them in vivid dreams, diagnosed disease and offered cures, and the grateful recipients of his wisdom would then throw golden coins into his sacred fountains...

The Sun is now transmitting these mysteries with transformative messages coming from Mercury also traveling through here until early next year suggesting this is a good time to remember to set an intent for healing cures during sleep with clear guidance coming through the dreamtime.

Nov 30, Wednesday. The Sun (8Sag46) is within one degree of Antares (9Sag46) making its exact conjunction at the New Moon (9Sag31) tomorrow. This sets up a powerful transmission point worthy of our conscious attention. The fixed star site describes Antares this way... **Antares** is a red binary star, fiery red and emerald green, near the center of the constellation [Scorpius](#) and was sometimes called "the Heart of the Scorpion". It is often more visible than the planet Mars and is sometimes confused with it when the positions are close. One of Antares' translations is Anti-Ares, meaning "Rival of Mars". The ancient inscriptions make much of it in connection with the planet Mars. Astrologers considered the Scorpion the House of that planet and that god its guardian. Thus it naturally followed the character of its constellation, — perhaps originated it, — and was always associated with eminence and activity in mankind.

This is one of the four key stars in the heavens, also called archangel stars. Michael ([Aldebaran](#)) watcher of the East. Gabriel ([Fomalhaut](#)) watcher of the South. Raphael ([Regulus](#)) Watcher of the North. Oriel (Antares)

Watcher of the West. At one time they marked the two Equinoxes and two Solstices. [Aldebaran](#) marked the zero Aries (March Equinox) point in 3044 BC, Antares marked zero Libra (September Equinox) 3052 BC, [Fomalhaut](#) marked zero Capricorn (December Solstice), 2582 BC, [Regulus](#) marked zero Cancer (June Solstice), 2345 BC....They have been characterized as Horses, reflected both in the famed Four Horsemen of Apocalypse (Revelations 6) and Chariot Horses in the Book of Zechariah. (Robson)

Residing at the heart of the Scorpion this star suggests it is through the heart, through love and forgiveness of ourselves and others, forgiving the unforgivable, that we can then unify the diversity of this dualistic life experience and know that it is *not either or but both and more*. This is powerful time for tuning into forgiveness and love as our most effective healing tool, remembering that when we love ourselves enough to release our need to be right and to have life be a certain way great profound joy is possible.
